

## About

This document provides detailed instructions for generating a live Kiosk view of PV site performance within the SolarEdge Monitoring platform and sharing it through a URL for display in public spaces, such as the lobby of a public building.

## overview

The SolarEdge Monitoring platform enables site owners to publicly display a live view (kiosk info) of their PV site's performance via a kiosk webpage (see image below), accessible through an internet connection. The page updates every five minutes and displays key site data, including power and energy production, environmental benefits, the owner or installer logo, and a site image. The display is optimized for a 16:9 screen aspect ratio. The display language is automatically set based on the device's location and local settings, with an option for manual adjustment.




## Setting up the kiosk view


This section provides details on how to setup a kiosk info through the Monitoring platform.

To set up the kiosk info follow the steps below:


1. Log in to the [Monitoring Platform](#) .
2. Enter your site name in the site search field to locate it in the sites list (see image below). Once it appears, select it to open the site's dashboard.




3. Once entered into the site's dashboard, click on the **Site Admin** button on the left (see image below).




4. Once Site Admin's menu is opened, on the left pane , select **Site Access** and then **Access Control**.



- Once **Access Control** menu is opened, check the **create link for public area display** checkbox (see image below).



- Kiosk View** menu is opened, enter the desired site name to be displayed in the kiosk view and then click **Save**.




- Only after clicking **Save**, the kiosk link is being generated. Once it is ready, copy the link using the **Copy** button. see below kiosk view once link is loaded in the browser.
