Troubleshooting SolarEdge Systems, Addendum (Europe & APAC)

This addendum is a supplement to the *SolarEdge Installation Guide versions 3.0* and above (P/N MAN-01-00057-3.0 and above; <u>http://www.solaredge.com/sites/default/files/se-inverter-installation-guide.pdf</u>). This document describes error codes and how to troubleshoot them.

Error Codes

The error messages include an error number (in firmware version 3.18xx and before) or a code (in firmware version 3.19xx and later, including 4.x) and a description:

XXX: The error number (firmware version 3.18xx and before).

(#-X#): A code indicating the source of error and the error information (firmware version 3.19xx and later, including 4.x).

Line 1-2: Error description

The error numbers/ codes may differ depending on the inverter type (single phase or three phase) as described in the table below. For troubleshooting errors that are not listed, contact SolarEdge support.

Make sure to have this information at hand when contacting SolarEdge Support for advanced troubleshooting.
